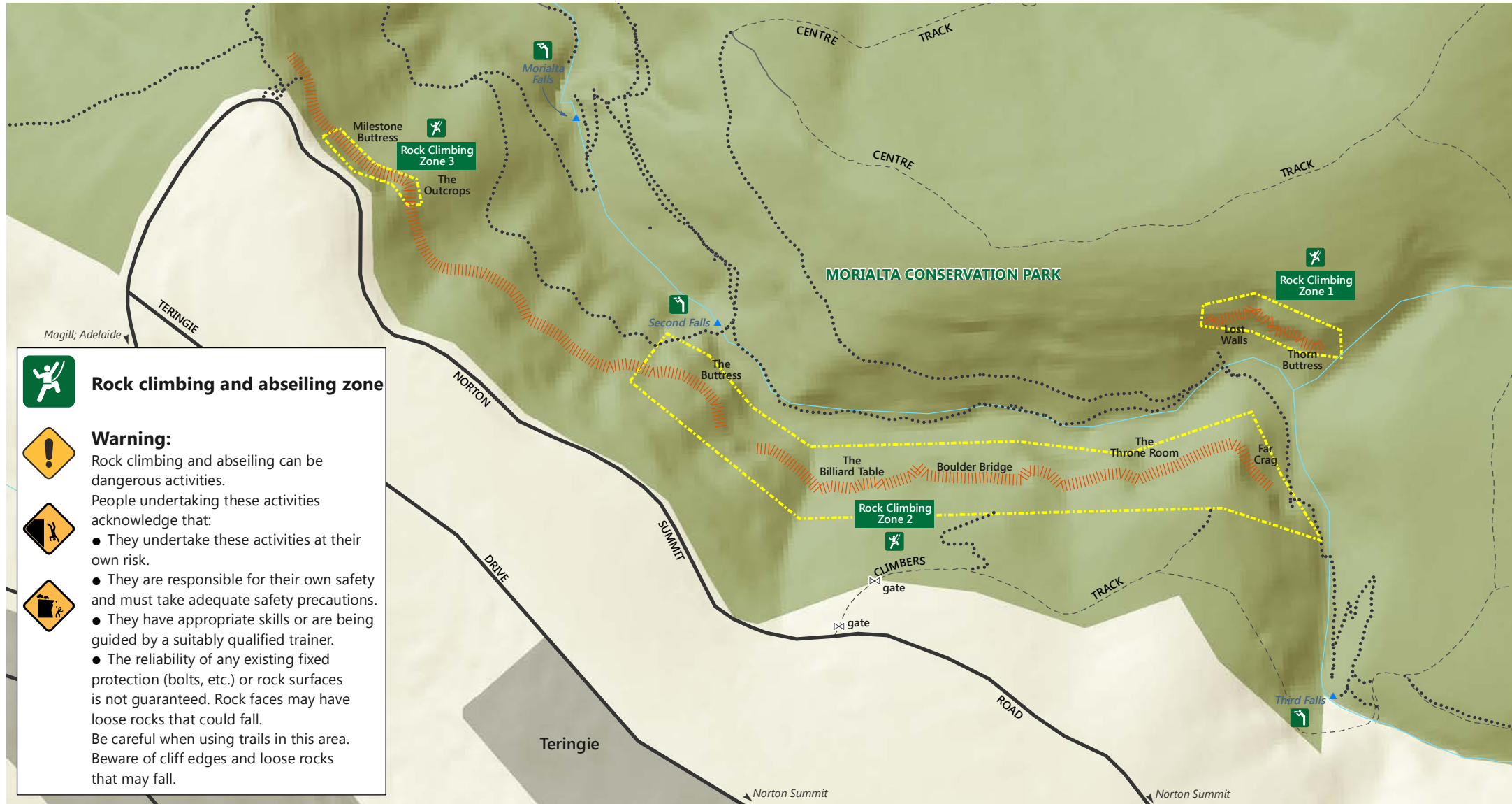

Rock climbing and abseiling zone

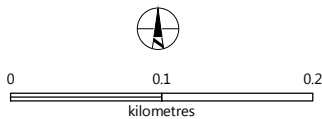


Warning:
